### **CIBSE to promote commissioning within construction**

The Chartered Institution of Building Services Engineers (CIBSE) and The Commissioning Specialists Association (CSA) have committed to working together to develop and promote the commissioning membership of the construction industry.

Marking the first day of CIBSE's 2007 National Conference, the signing of the Memorandum of Understanding builds on previous work between the two organisations as 'partners in building services excellence' and provides shared access to member benefits and services.

The National Conference, entitled The Business of Change, had a successful first day with speakers such as Deputy Mayor of London Nicky Gavron and Judith Armitt, Chief Executive for Thames Gateway, as well as a panel session on The Stern Review.
