The new colours and a reminder of our different memberships are as follows



CSA Individual Members and CM Grades

Individual membership is aimed at those field engineers who are actively involved in the commissioning process.

The Commissioning Manager grades should be applied for by people undertaking Commissioning Management or by specialist engineers



CSA Associate Members

Associate membership is aimed at organisations that are connected with the industry, but whose main business may be outside the pure commissioning activity, e.g. installation companies, equipment suppliers, instrumentation suppliers, consultant engineers, etc.



CSA Corporate Members

Corporate membership is aimed at organisations whose main or only business is the commissioning of building services systems.



CSA Individual Associate Members

This category was formed in 2003 to accommodate individuals who are not doing commissioning in the UK but are affiliated to commissioning through other trades, i.e. electrical, mechanical engineers etc
